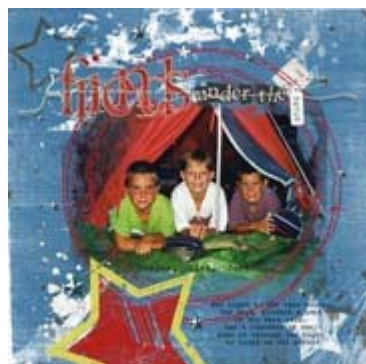

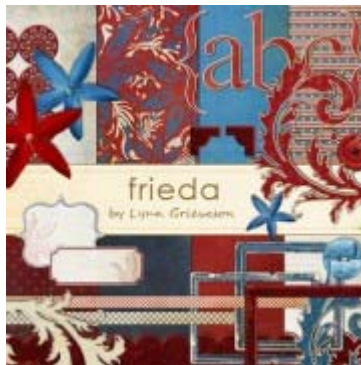

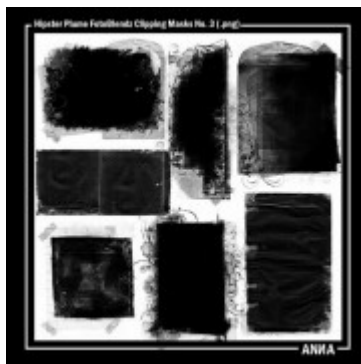

Photoshop: The Final Frontier

Captain's Log: Stardate 2009. We have entered the Scrapping Zone on an assignment to preserve memory units. Our dilemma: we find ourselves needing to apply the cloak of invisibility to a number of layers in our document.

We know that we can hide one layer by clicking on the **Layer Visibility icon** next to the layer we want to hide. Represented by an eyeball, this icon is easy to find on the left side of each layer.

Seeking a more efficient solution than clicking on each layer one at a time, we find that we can click on one of these icons and drag downward in a row

to hide many layers in mere seconds.

Having defeated the Klingons of time, we can now Live Long and Remember.
