

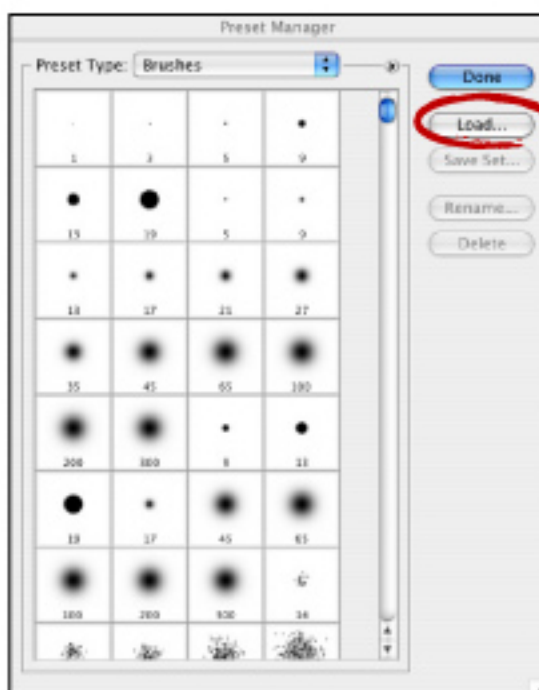
Photoshop Brushes 101 with Katie & Pattie of DesignerDigitals.com

Loading Brushes

> Launch Photoshop
> Edit > Preset Manager
click on 'Load' button

Locate your brush file

Your new brushes will be visible in the brush palette



Creating Brushes

A common cry we hear is ::eek:: the brushes I just bought won't load OR the brushes I just bought aren't compatible with Photoshop 7

never fear! ;) that's why most all designers include PNG files with their brushes, so you can make your own brushes in 3 easy steps!

step 1

open the PNG file

step 2

using the rectangular marquee tool, select the item to be made into a brush

step 3

Edit > Define Brush preset & name your brush!

Saving Brush Sets

You've made a great new stamp and you want to send it to your friend, how do you save it? Back to the preset manager...

Edit > Preset Manager

select the items in the palette you want to make into a set

[use ctrl +click or command+click for mac users to select non-sequential items]

Select 'Save Set'

name your set and save it!
